The Health Equity Action Transformation Community Advisory Board (HEAT CAB) was formed with the intention of activating the recently released Health Equity Action Transformation (HEAT) Report to provide a recognized platform for community to voice opinions and concerns about important decision-making processes that directly affect their life and well-being. The purpose of the HEAT CAB is to take action to improve lived experiences, to build trust, and to develop a mutual understanding between residents and the institutions or organizations that provide, or are seeking to provide services to the community.

 This workshop with Design Impact also included CHIP subject matter expert training for the Community Action Board.

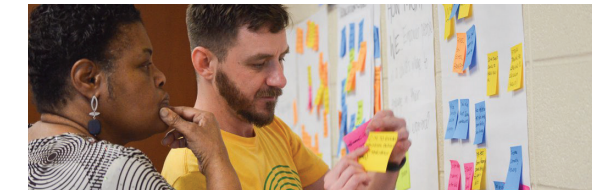

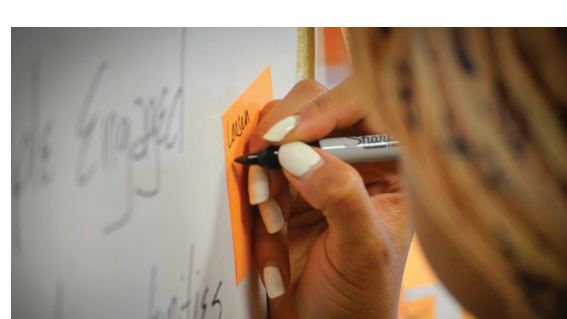


EMPATHIC COMMUNITY INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED
 214 empathic interviews were conducted with residents of Wyandotte County. Interviews centered around residents' lived experiences with health inequities as identified by HEAT Report and/or with any of the four CHIP priority issues

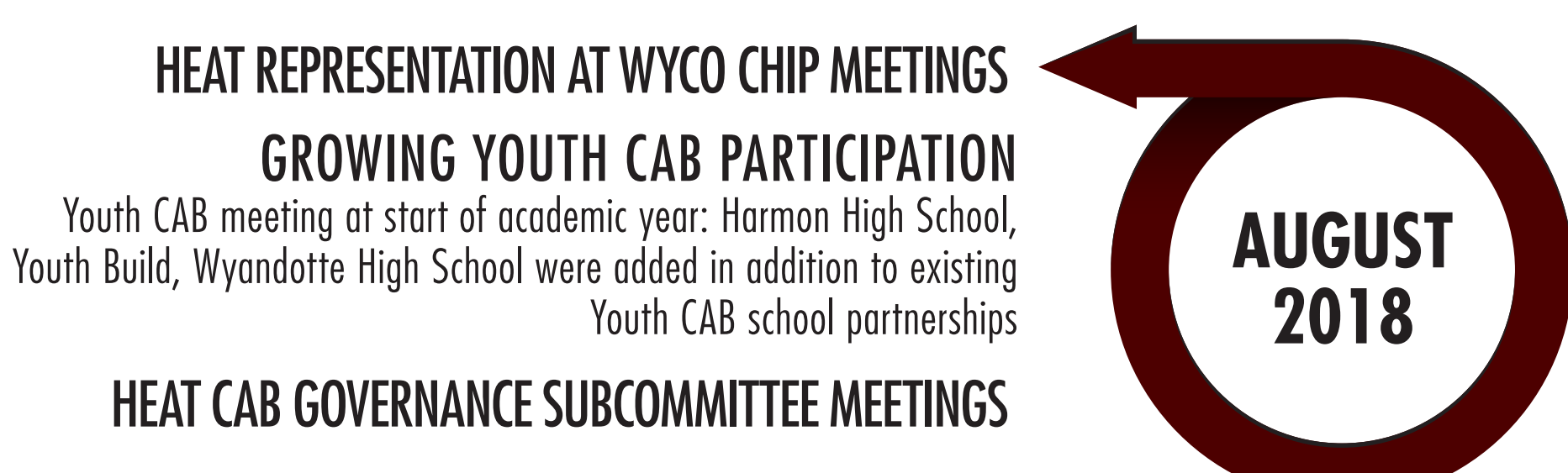
DESIGN IMPACT WORKSHOP
 Generated four community workgroups, each worked to synthesize data from empathic interviews, develop prototypes of community-based interventions, and narrow focus based on prototype experimentation and feedback.

LAUNCH OF YOUTH COMMUNITY ACTION BOARD
 Recognized process was well aligned with community comments about importance of youth engagements, we invited youth into design space to develop youth project. Development of Youth Community Action Board. Youth CAB conversations reinforced insights from HEAT CAB empathic interviews - allowed CAB to dig deep into this focus on youth (Adults and Youth - saying the same things about urgency on youth engagement)
